



1. During inclement weather, the safety of students and coaching staff is the primary concern when determining if riding exercises can be conducted safely.

a. Riding exercises will not be conducted during inclement weather (thunderstorm, windstorm, heavy rain, etc.), or if Installation Safety Office leadership and/or RiderCoaches determine the safety of students and/or coaching staff are at risk.

(1) Cancelation of courses will occur once it has been determined inclement weather will not pass or subside. Students will be offered the opportunity to resume training on a makeup date or be moved to another scheduled class.

2. Tropical Cyclone Condition of Readiness (TCCOR) can change at a moment's notice during the typhoon season (June - November). Schedule changes for riding exercises and/or course cancellations apply when the following typhoon conditions have been declared:

a. Tropical Cyclone Condition of Readiness 1 (TCCOR-1)

(1) Prior to 1130 (Mon-Fri): classes will be postponed or cancelled and students notified as soon as possible.

(2) After 1300 (Mon-Fri): classes will continue until 1600, pending safe riding conditions.

b. Tropical Cyclone Condition of Readiness 1 Caution (<u>TCCOR-1C</u>): The Motorcycle Safety Office will be closed and students attending classes will be dismissed so they may return to their command/residence. Prior to release, they will be informed of schedule/class changes accordingly.

c. Tropical Cyclone Condition of Readiness Storm Watch (<u>TCCOR-SW</u>): Students should contact the Motorcycle Safety Office at 634-2450 for the status of updated class schedules that may be affected by typhoon conditions.
