Bag #1 Combustible Waste

- ✓ Use clear plastic bags (Up to 35 gal max)
- ✓ Do not mix with non-combustible waste
- ✓ Place in a trash enclosure

Examples:

- *Non-Recyclable Paper & Plastic
- *Kitchen Waste
- *Clothes, Bags, Shoes, etc.



No batteries, light bulbs or ammunition.

Bag #2 Non-Combustible Waste

- ✓ Use clear plastic bags (Up to 10 gal max)
- ✓ Do not mix with combustible waste
- ✓ Place in a trash enclosure

Examples:

- *Tableware, Toner Cartridges, 'Small' Home Appliances
- *Any waste attached with non-combustible materials i.e., metal/glass



No batteries, light bulbs or ammunition.

Bulk Waste

- 1) Unserviceable pallets/wood
- 2) E-Waste
- 3) Combustibles (plastic, rubber textile, etc.)
- 4) Non-Combustibles (C&D debris, metal/glass-mixed, etc.)
- 5) Combustible and Non-Combustible Waste that do not fit in their bag size limit

✓ Consider turning in government property to DLA first.
