3. Island-Wide Spill Prevention & Response (FY24 carry over)	 A. All-services MOA update (USMC, USN, USA, USAF, DLA, JGSDF) B. Okinawa-specific Contract for large-scale spill response
4. AFFF/PFAS (FY24 carry over)	 A. Correct Deficiencies in remaining four Discharge Containment Tanks B. Implementation of MCICOM AFFF sundown guidance C. Camp FUT Fire Training Facility with high temp concrete, award FY25
