

**SPECIAL POWER OF ATTORNEY
(SELL VEHICLE, NON ROTATING)**

PREAMBLE: This is a MILITARY POWER OF ATTORNEY prepared pursuant to Title 10 United States Code, Section 1044b, and executed by a person authorized to receive legal assistance from the military services. Federal law exempts this power of attorney from any requirement of form, substance, formality, or recording that is prescribed for powers of attorney by the laws of a state, the District of Columbia, or a territory, commonwealth, or possession of the United States. Federal law specifies that this power of attorney shall be given the same legal effect as a power of attorney prepared and executed in accordance with the laws of the jurisdiction where it is presented. **Your unit Adjutant (S-1 OIC), CO, XO, and Navy and Marine Corps officers in the grade of O-4 and above are authorized to act as federal notaries.**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

I, _____, have this day appointed _____, to serve as my true and lawful Agent, GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said agent full power to:

Sell or otherwise dispose of my motor vehicle (whose description follows) for such sum and upon such terms and conditions as my Agent shall deem best and to receive the proceeds of said sale:

To transfer title thereto; to cancel, in my name, the registration and insurance of said vehicle. Operate and drive, control, protect, preserve, repair, authorize repairs, store, maintain and properly care for my motor vehicle above described automobile. Make claims for and sue damages to said vehicle; to advance court costs, other costs of litigation and to retain an attorney for such fee and upon such terms and conditions as my Agent shall deem best; to negotiate and arbitrate said claim for damages and to make settlement for same upon such terms and conditions and for such sums as my Agent shall deem best; and to receive the proceeds from said claim, settlement, arbitration or suit. Make claim for damages to said vehicle against my insurance company or any other insurance company and to receive the proceeds of any such settlement or judgment. To sign and execute, verify and acknowledge, receive, deliver and record, any and all applications, certificates, automobile titles, bills of sale, contract of sale, proofs of loss, releases, release vouchers, receipts and other instruments, documents of papers necessary, proper or convenient to accomplish the foregoing.

FURTHER, I do authorize my agent to perform all necessary acts in the execution of the aforesaid authorization with the same validity as I could effect if personally present. I further declare that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder by me said agent shall be binding on myself and my heirs; legal and personal representatives, and assigns whether the same shall be done either before or after my death, or other revocation of the instrument, unless and until reliable intelligence or notice thereof shall have been received by my said agent.

PROVIDED, however, that all actions taken hereunder for me or for my account shall be transacted in my name, and that all endorsements and instruments executed by my said agent for the purpose of carrying out the foregoing powers shall contain my name, followed by that of my said agent and the designation "Agent."

FURTHER, I declare that this power shall remain in effect even though I am reported or listed officially or otherwise, as "missing," "missing in action," or "prisoner of war" it being my intention that the designation of such status shall not bar my said agent from fully and completely exercising and continuing to exercise any and all powers and rights herein granted until this power is revoked by my death or as otherwise provided herein.

FURTHER, this power shall not be affected should I subsequently become disabled or incapacitated.

This Power of Attorney shall become effective when I sign and execute it below. Unless sooner revoked or terminated by me, this Power of Attorney shall become NULL and VOID on _____ day of _____ 20 _____ (*expiration date*).

Notwithstanding my inclusion of a specific expiration date herein, if on the above-specified expiration date, or during the sixty (60) day period preceding that specified expiration date, I should be or have been determined by the United States Government to be in a military status of

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"missing," "missing in action," or "prisoner of war," or if I should be or have been properly certified, in writing, by a physician to be disabled from or incapable of exercising control over my person, property, personal affairs, or financial affairs, then this Power of Attorney shall remain valid and in full effect until sixty (60) days after I have returned to United States military control following termination of such status or sixty (60) days after I have recovered from such disability unless sooner revoked or terminated by me.

All business transacted hereunder for me or for my account shall be transacted in my name, and all endorsements and instruments executed by my Agent for the purpose of carrying out the foregoing powers shall contain my name, followed by that of my Agent and the designation "Agent."
