1. Purpose. To publish scheduled safety training classes provided by the MCIPAC-MCBB, Installation Safety Office (ISO).

2. Action. All training classes are limited to a maximum of (25) students and a minimum of (10) students with the exception of respiratory protection class which has a maximum of (15) students. Participation is highly encouraged for all personnel regardless of rank or billet, with the exception of Supervisor Safety which is reserved for those in supervisory positions. Quotas are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis unless otherwise posted. The deadline for registration is three working days prior to the scheduled course date. If less than ten students register by the deadline, the course will be cancelled and enrolled personnel will be notified via email.

3. The Ground Safety for Marines (GSFM) course is for unit level Ground Safety Officers/Managers. Students attending the GSFM course must be E-6 or above, be appointed in writing as the Ground Safety Officer/Manager (GSO/GSM), and have at least one year remaining on station. Class size for this course is limited to (30) students.

Personnel assigned to an MCIPAC installation/station will coordinate with their local installation/station safety office for a course quota.

Asbestos Inspector is scheduled for Apr 22-24 from 0730-1630 in the Installation Safety Office, building 5831 on Camp Foster. Course quotas are managed through eNTRS as listed above.

Asbestos Management Planner is scheduled for 25-26 April from 0730-1630 in the Installation Safety Office, building 5831 on Camp Foster. Course quotas are managed through eNTRS as listed above.

Asbestos Inspector Refresher is scheduled for 26 April from 1200-1600 in the Installation Safety Office, building 5831 on Camp Foster. Course quotas are managed through eNTRS as listed above.

Marine Corps Ground Mishap Investigation Course is scheduled for Aug 26-30 from 0730-1630 in the Installation Safety Office, building 5831 on Camp Foster. Course quotas are controlled by the MCIPAC-MCBB Installation Safety Office (ISO) for Marine Corps region installations and stations and III MEF Safety for operational commands. Quotas are reserved for full-time Safety & Occupational Health Specialists and unit level Ground Safety Officers/Managers. This course is limited to 25 students per session.
