1. Purpose. To publish scheduled safety training classes provided by the MCIPAC-MCBB, Installation Safety Office (ISO).

2. Action. All training classes are limited to a maximum of (15) students and a minimum of (10) students with the exception of respiratory protection classes which have a maximum of (13) students. Participation is highly encouraged for all personnel regardless of rank or billet, with the exception of Supervisor Safety which is reserved for those in supervisory positions grades E-4 and above and civilian equivalent. Quotas are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis unless otherwise posted. The deadline for registration is three working days prior to the scheduled course date. If less than (10) students register by the deadline, the course will be cancelled and enrolled personnel will be notified via email.

3. The Ground Safety for Marines (GSM) course is for unit level Ground Safety Officers/Managers. Students attending the GSM course must be E-6 or above, be appointed in writing as the Ground Safety Officer/Manager (GSO/GSM) by the commanding officer, and have at least one year remaining on station to fulfill GSO/GSM duties. Class size for this course is limited to (15) students.
