- 1. The facilitator for this meeting was the Camp Operations Officer.
- 2. The representatives of Camp tenants were in attendance per enclosure (1).
- 3. The following agenda items were discussed, per the enclosure (2).
- a. Significant events calendar. The calendar was reviewed and over the course of the meeting, the below events were highlighted for the month of March, per enclosure (2).
- (1) On 7 March there will be a Tsunami evacuation working group in order to discuss challenges regarding the evacuation of the elementary school and child care centers.
 - (2) The following community events were highlighted:
 - (a) On 2 March the School Aged Center will be having a Dr. Suess Day
 - (b) On 3 March, the library will be hosting a Dr. Seuss Birthday Party from 1000 to 1100.
- (c) On 10 March, from 1230 to 1800, there will be a military Softball Tournament at the softball field next to Roberts Field. There will be food, entertainment, and music for all to enjoy.
- (d) On 17 March, from 1900 to 2100, the Surfside will be host a St. Patrick's Day celebration, with specialty drinks and appetizers being served in all of the lounges.
- (e) From 1 to 29 March, the Surfside will be having a sign-up for the World's Biggest Easter Basket. Buffet patrons can drop their receipt with their name and phone number into the box at the register. The drawing will be on Easter Family Fun Night on 29 March from 1700 to 2100.
 - (f) On 1 April, the Surfside will be hosting an Easter Brunch from 0900 to 1400.
- (e) On 21 April, the USO in coordination with Environmental will be hosting Wood Stock to celebrate Earth Day.
- (f) April is the month of the military child. On 20 April, from 1500 to 1700, the CDC, School Aged Center, and Youth and Teen center will be having an event at the CDC in recognition of the month.
 - b. The 30-60-90 day outlook was reviewed.

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- c. Tenant organizations briefed their current initiatives and concerns, per enclosure (2).
- (1) Combat Logistics Regiment 35 highlighted that the preponderance of the regiment will be deployed from 27 March to 15 May.
- (2) Headquarters Regiment requested a working group in July regarding Typhoon response in order to familiarize new staff members following the summer change over.
- d. The Camp Commander introduced to tenants the intent and plan to charter and implement a community resiliency team in response to the impact of school violence on the Kinser community.

3. Tasks from the meeting were:

a. Camp Operations

- (1) Disseminate MCCS and USO events via Facebook, Marines.mil, and FROs.
- (2) Provide means of formal back-briefing to tenants regarding the outputs from the monthly table top exercises and anticipated impacts regarding emergency action plans.
- (3) Add a working group/rehearsal of concept for Typhoon response to the camp calendar in late July.
 - (4) Ensure safety banners are taken from Gates 3 and 4 and placed at Gates 1 and 2.
- (5) Coordinate with Base Safety to ensure the proper dissemination of safety information and tips to tenants and residents.
- (6) Coordinate with PMO to get SOFA and non-SOFA traffic lane signage for Gate 2 to enable security augmentation force (SAF) to assist with morning gate traffic.

b. Bachelor Housing Manager

- (1) Draft a point paper and/or story board in order to quantify and highlight the impacts of mold in barracks 1217 and the inability to secure rooms due to the VingCard Key System issues.
- (2) Coordinate a meeting with the Camp Director and Camp Commander to discuss the point paper and/or story board and develop methods to address the situation to higher.
- (3) Develop a slide chart with forecasted unaccompanied housing renovations, similar to the Family Housing product.
- 4. Due-ins for the next meeting are:
 - a. Status update regarding the replacement of unit marshalling area/Training Area 2...
 - b. Status update regarding purchase/installment process for industrial washers/dryers.
 - c. Status update regarding the engineer study for mold in barracks 1217 and 1224.

Building 506, bay 1, has had a leak in the fire suppression system that has taken over one year to repair. Camp Kinser operations will continue to work with Facilities Engineering to determine why the work request has taken so long to address.


