- 1. The facilitator for this meeting was the Camp Operations Officer.
- 2. The representatives of Camp tenants were in attendance per enclosure (1).
- 3. The following agenda items were discussed, per the enclosure (2).
- a. Significant events calendar. The calendar was reviewed and over the course of the meeting, the below events were highlighted for the month of November, per enclosure (3).
 - (1) The Camp Kinser Obstacle Course will be demolished from 12 to 15 December.
 - (2) The Kinser Elementary School Winter Concert will be held 15 December.
 - (3) Kinser Festival has been rescheduled for 27 and 28 January 2018.
 - (4) The following MCCS events were highlighted:
- (a) Barracks Door Decorating Contest will be held from 1 to 20 December. The winning rooms from each Regiment will receive a \$225 MCCS Gift Card to share between the residents.
- (b) 13 December Santa will be visiting the Mess Hall from 1100-1230 with gifts for Marines and Sailors.
- (c) On 14 December from 1700-1800 at the Library, Santa will be having a gift wrapping workshop for parents to sneak away to in order to wrap gifts.
- (d) On 21 December from 1700 to 2100 at Surfside will be a Super Family Fun Night with Santa. There will be a traditional holiday meal, DJ, and Santa!
- (e) On 24 December and 31 December there will be a hot meal delivery to all Marines on duty.
 - b. The 30-60-90 day outlook was reviewed.
 - Tenant organizations briefed their current initiatives and concerns, per enclosure (2).
- 3. Outputs from the meeting were:

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a. Camp Operations

- (1) Regarding Kinser Festival:
- (a) Resend Automated Message Handling Feasibility of Support to units in order to get required support for the Festival.
- (b) Distribute Camp Letter of Instruction, Security Augmentation Force Activation Order, tentative traffic plans, and Special Event Force Protection Plan to required offices and tenants.
- (3) Distribute Marine Family Housing Dashboard to Camp Kinser tenants. This is provided via enclosure (4).

b. Facilities Chief

- Provide an updated Gantt timeline to tenants for construction aboard Camp Kinser, provided via enclosure (5).
- (2) Coordinate with Marine Corps Installations Pacific, GF, to provide infrastructure reset analysis results to tenants. Coordinate a brief to explain the outputs and what this means for tenants in the future.
 - Environmental requested to be contacted regarding all spills, no matter the size...
- d. The Camp Kinser Exchange requested assistance with informing residents regarding upcoming holiday hours. The Camp will share the information using Facebook and the Family Readiness Officers (FRO) for tenants.

 - (a) This RFI was sent to the Base Property Control Office (BPCO)
- (b) Answer received: "Per Mr Anthony Anderson, BPCO Deputy he stated; "USMC SERVMART is a mandatory source of supply for items not purchased via an Approved Program System of Record (APSR) e.g. GCSS-MC. We will find a source who can support your

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requirement or provide a suitable replacement based off the specifications. The requirement maybe sourced via our 4PL, DLA or RCO. Funding for PSE normally comes from MCICOM".

- b. From Combat Logistics Regiment 35:
- (1) With the laundry replacement facility being placed in Training Area 2, what is the plan to recoup the lost Unit Marshalling space?
- (a) Camp Kinser Operations will work with MCIPAC-GF to develop courses of action to provide the space in other locations aboard Camp Kinser.
- (b) Potential locations include the space North West of Building 107 and the land south of the softball field in vicinity of Gate 5.

 - b. Status update regarding purchase/installment process for industrial washers/dryers.


